Dear Minister:

We are writing to you today as Christian churches and religious organizations representing Christians from a wide variety of denominations across Canada. As you know, today, forty percent of the world's population is living in countries that are forced to spend more on repaying debts than on health, education or tackling the climate crisis.

We are deeply troubled by the impact this current debt crisis is having on the lives of the poorest and most vulnerable across the world. In 2000, hundreds of thousands of Canadians signed a petition calling for debt cancellation as part of a "Jubilee Year." In the Christian tradition, a Jubilee Year is a time of mercy and justice, where debts are released. Twenty-five years later, when the need for action is even more urgent, we join Pope Francis along with dozens of other organizations around the world in launching a renewed effort for global debt cancellation and structural reform. We must work together for an economic system that centres justice, Indigenous rights and the protection of the environment for the benefit of all.

We are requesting a meeting with your office to discuss how Canada's Ministers can play a leadership role in championing the issue of debt justice at important multilateral forums, including COP30 in Brazil and the G20 meeting in South Africa. We are especially interested to see Canada make debt justice a key priority on the agenda of the G7 Summit in Kananaskis in June. We look forward to engaging in a constructive dialogue with you and your team.

To demonstrate public support, members of our churches and organizations are currently signing a global petition in churches and communities across Canada. We are calling on political leaders to act with courage and compassion to:

- 1. Stop the debt crisis now by cancelling and remedying unjust and unsustainable debts, without economic policy conditions;
- Prevent debt crises from happening again by addressing their root causes by reforming the global financial system to prioritize people and the planet;
- 3. Establish a permanent, transparent, binding and comprehensive debt framework within the United Nations.

We look forward to your prompt response indicating your availability for a meeting. On behalf of the thousands of Christians in Canada concerned about this issue and many others throughout the world, we appreciate your consideration.
